What is Weatherization?

Some ways to weatherize your home include:

- Add weather-stripping around exterior doors and windows that have a draft.
- Use outlet plugs to close the holes on exterior walls when not in use.
- Apply caulk around light fixtures and other gaps.

An energy audit helps identify possible areas of energy loss, from which our team provides recommendations on how you can conserve energy, reduce areas of energy loss, and increase comfort in your home.

Thermostats

Ideal Settings for When Your Heat Is On:

- When you're home: 65-68°F
- When you're away for 2+ days: 60-65°F
- 60°F minimum if four-legged family members are home


Hot Water Heaters

- Lower the thermostat on your water heater to 120°F.
- Add an insulated blanket to your water heater (found at your local building supply store). The thicker insulation you use, the more energy you will conserve.
